

# **Effigy Mounds National Monument**

The 2,526-acre park is divided into two units (North and South) by the Yellow River. Walking trails provide modest to extended routes, allowing you to select your route and view a variety of mounds. An accessible boardwalk trail into the wetlands near the Visitor Center is available for disabled visitors and persons of all walking abilities.

# Yellow River State Forest

Located in Southeast Allamakee County, 729 State Forest Road, forest entrance via Harpers Ferry or State Highway 76. Yellow River State Forest was first acquired as a state forest in 1935, the Yellow River State Forest has grown to encompass nearly 9,000 acres of natural beauty.

# See the inspiration for Grant Wood's iconic piece of American art...

In 1930, Grant Wood took a tour of Eldon, a small Iowa town, and spotted a little white house with a large gothic-style window. Inspired, Wood quickly sketched the house and returned home to Cedar Rapids to paint *American Gothic*.

The house still stands to this day and its exterior is viewed by thousands of people each year. The adjacent **visitor center** welcomes travelers from near and far, providing services for the site, including an exhibit gallery and a gift shop.

Eldon is located in the southeast corner of Wapello County approximately eleven miles straight southeast of Ottumwa– a town with big-city amenities and small-town hospitality. It is sixteen miles by car between the two cities using US highways 34 and 16.

In addition, the house is not easily accessible for individuals with mobility issues. There is a slight hill leading up to the house, two steps to get onto the porch, and one step to get inside the house.
- Bus parking (option to obtain video in advance for viewing on the bus)
- Restrooms (two stalls for women and one stall for men)
- Center is wheelchair accessible and there is one wheelchair available on-site
- Two outdoor picnic tables on-site but other outdoor shelters are near
- Monday or Tuesday tours may be available- contact Cari for details

Visit length depends on how many people you have in your group and which activities you participate in. Visits vary between 30 and 90 minutes. Admission prices start at \$5 each ages 13-59 and \$4 each ages 60+, discounts based on group size. Coming soon: educational classroom for personalized programs!
